Blogging Content Guidelines

The *Your SF Public Schools* coalition is a group of 17 organizations working together to promote engagement, volunteerism, and support of public education in San Francisco.

The website blog is designed to promote community-wide conversation about what matters most to San Franciscans in their public schools, and to advance new solutions and ideas about how San Franciscans might engage to support public education. The blog is facilitated on a rotating basis by members of the coalition.

Guest bloggers—Guest bloggers subject-area experts or leaders in their field—are invited by the facilitators to share a 400-word perspective on a topic of choice. When submitting a blog, all guest bloggers agree that the blog facilitators reserve the right to edit the posts at their discretion to adhere to the coalition’s standards of non-discrimination, solution-seeking, and respecting the rights of all San Franciscans.

Blog commentary—All members of the community are invited and encouraged to comment on the guest blog posts and engage in the conversation. These posts may be of any length, and are not edited for content.

While most comments will be posted if they are on-topic and not abusive, moderating decisions are subjective. We cannot review individual moderation decisions with readers and generally cannot alter a comment once it is posted. We make an effort to protect discussions from repeated comments – either by the same reader or different readers and will not post comments from the same reader more than twice per week. Personal attacks, obscenity, vulgarity, profanity (including expletives and letters followed by dashes), commercial promotion, impersonations, incoherence and SHOUTING will not be approved.

The blog facilitators reserve the right not to post a blog and to ban those individuals who consistently violate the standards and mission of this site.
